Cyril Goulding Trophy

Description

The Cyril Goulding Trophy is awarded by the committee to any member who in their opinion has done the most in the preceding year to further the objectives of the Society.

History

Cyril Goulding was the President of the St Mellon's Society for many years and presented this trophy in 1974.

Trophy Management

The trophy is presented annually. It is normally awarded at the society social evening held in the first quarter of the year. If a social evening is not held then the trophy can be awarded at a time to be decided by the committee.

The trophy is held by the winner for a period of 11 months, after which it must be returned to the event organiser to enable sufficient time for the next winner's details to be engraved on the trophy. A smaller plaque is then awarded to the winner, which can be retained.

Competition Rules

- The event is open to all current members of the society.
- Any member may recommend any other member to the Committee for this award.

Judging Procedure

The Committee will consider the merits of all club members and award the trophy appropriately. The decision will be announced at the society social evening held in the first quarter of the year. If a social evening is not held then the announcement can be made at a time to be decided by the committee.
